The Renault Alpine Vision concept has the Porsche 718 Cayman in its sights

At a lavish event in Monaco that featured over 90 of the marque’s A110 Berlinettes, Renault Alpine took another step towards its long-awaited new sports car by revealing the Vision concept...

80% there...



Monte Carlo was an apt place for Renault to reveal the new Alpine Vision concept, given the [A110’s success on the famous rally](#). Visually very similar to the Alpine Celebration concept that was first shown in 2015, the Vision concept is said to be 80% of the way to the forthcoming production car, which will be unveiled before the end of this year. Pleasingly, the mid-engined coupé takes clear aesthetic inspiration from its distant relation, including its diminutive dimensions. Rumoured to weigh just 1,100kg and to be powered by a circa-250bhp turbocharged four-cylinder engine, the production car will allegedly be fast and fun to drive. And priced in the region of £40,000, it’ll have [Porsche’s four-cylinder 718 Cayman](#) firmly in its sights. Though it’s yet *another* step towards the final product, we’re pleased to see the project is still on track.
