Designed to satisfy the high international demand for [Diamond Atelier's](#) products, the Mark II Series will be limited to 10 pieces, and available in three stages of performance trim. The popular Munich-based custom motorcycle builder considers the 'timeless' shape of the Mark II its best design to date, and it's easy to see why. The low-slung BMW-powered café racer is restrained and minimal, yet somehow bold and brazen at the same time – especially in the ultra-cool khaki colour scheme.
