In 2017, it was found sheltered in a barn with just 27,225 miles and shipped to the UK, marking the start of a four year restoration involving some of the UK's leading Porsche experts. After being stripped back to bare metal, repairs and custom modifications were carried out on the body, while the engine and gearbox (which are original to the car) were completely rebuilt along with the running gear, suspension and brakes. With a gorgeous exterior ready to wow onlookers, work began on the bespoke interior. Luxurious Scottish Moorhead leather adorns the seats, while German weave carpets and professionally refurbished original gauges complete what looks to be an absolutely immaculate cabin.
