In fact, this is the only Figoni et Falaschi-bodied Teardrop Coupé built on the T150 C Lago Spéciale chassis. This combination of flowing, aerodynamic coachwork and powerful mechanical underpinnings proved to be fearsome in competition, with this unique Talbot Lago winning its class at the 1948 24 Hours of Spa.



Even ignoring this Teardrop Coupé's impressive track record, its design alone is enough to place it among the most desirable automobiles ever made. The exterior is the epitome of Art Deco styling, while the cabin resembles something out of Lord of the Rings.
