Editor's Choice: 2007 TVR T350C

Since the sad demise of the British sports car manufacturer, TVRs have become an increasingly rare sight on the roads. Of those that are left, few are as special as this T350C found in the Classic Driver Market, which has covered just 12,500 miles from new.

Time and again, TVR appeared to have secured financing to remain a fully-fledged sports car builder – but with the 'shell' company now only offering 'reborn' models, it's pretty clear that the quirky Blackpool resident is a shadow of its former self.

However, anyone looking for a memento of the ill-fated manufacturer's former glory could do a lot worse than this T350C on sale from Classic Driver dealer <u>Hilton & Moss</u>. One of the last of its type registered, it comes in a fetching colour combination of Tungsten Grey over Carbon Black leather, and has just 12,500 miles on the clock. Those miles have been extensively documented by a TVR specialist, and the vehicle has had a pre-sale inspection and road test.



Those looking for ample power (350bhp from a 3.6-litre in-line six) in a lightweight (just over a tonne) package might enjoy a T350C. This attractive example is on sale for £32,950.
