## Full quota of Bugattis to descend on Wilton House

Bugatti enthusiasts rejoice – at the 2015 Wilton House Classic & Supercar event, taking place on 6 and 7 June, a number of historic Bugattis will gather to celebrate the tenth anniversary of their youngest descendant: the Veyron...

Inspired largely by the <u>event founder Lord Pembroke</u>'s love of the marque, the display will begin with the oldest racing car - Ettore Bugatti's 1913 Type 18 and culminate with one of the most recent offerings, the Veyron Pur Sang. Other prominent Bugattis on display will include a 1926 Type 41 Royale, a 1931 Type 54 Grand Prix car, and the prototype Bugatti Type 73 C developed the year Ettore died. In total, at least 16 important Bugattis will be on display, along with, no doubt, a few more in the visitor car park. There will also be a full set of <u>Aston Martin</u> 'DB' production cars on display, from DB2 to DB9 (and supplemented by a DB3S).

The 2015 Wilton House Classic & Supercar event takes place on 6 and 7 June 2015 in Wiltshire, southwest England.
