Given the burgeoning global market for SUVs, this pioneering new vehicle will capitalise on the Evoque's already fierce popularity – especially, we imagine, in warmer climes, just as the original Range Rover convertible conversions once did. While Land Rover's claim that this is "the most exclusive and capable convertible in the world" is bold, the idea of a drop-top SUV to use all year round is certainly appealing.
