Using an R nineT as its base, Nmoto strips the bike back to its frame before fitting 96 handcrafted pieces that combine to form a faithful homage to the R7, one of the all-time most sensational pieces of motorcycle design. And because of its modern underpinnings, this incredible, innovative custom motorcycle boasts all the creature comforts you'd expect, including LED lights, keyless ignition, adjustable suspension, and a boxer engine with sufficient power for everyday use.
