In the previous two seasons, legendary drivers such as David Coulthard and Karl Wendlinger have taken the wheel of the mighty 'Gullwing' and competed at such prestigious events as the Goodwood Members' Meeting in England and the Arosa ClassicCar in Switzerland - and having mastered the slippery, twisting roads 1,800 metres above sea level around St. Moritz, the stage is set for an epic 2020.
