The Goodwood Revival might have been cancelled because of the coronavirus, but the substitute behind-closed-doors Speedweek event, poised to take place from 16-18 October was reason enough for Bonhams to stage another collector car sale at the historic West Sussex motor circuit. Over 100 cars - ranging from affordable modern classics such as the quirky Pininfarina-designed Cadillac Allanté Convertible (est. £10,000-15,000) to blue-chip icons such as the low-mileage Ferrari F40 (£900,000-1.3m) will cross the block on 17 October, in addition to a plethora of exciting automobilia.



Three intriguing single-owner collections will also feature prominently, offering the chance for discerning collectors to augment their autumns. From pre-War Grand Tourers to modern supercars constructed by every major marque, the Chester Collection, Alps to Goodwood Collection and Collection of a Respected Gentleman Racer should have virtual paddles flying up in the air come 17 October.
