If the AMG GT's somewhat muffled growl isn't quite menacing enough, Historics Auctioneers' sale has plenty of Aston Martins to stick a bid on, including a 2014 V12 Vantage S, good for over 560 horsepower and a soundtrack that's truly like nothing else on the road.





If these sporty coupès aren't eye catching for you, £100,000 can thankfully get you some seriously special machines, including a Ferrari 599 finished in Grigio Silverstone Metallic, arguably one of the prancing horse's finest shades.
